Each month we will dig into our archives and ponder on the past and present minutia of our club.....


I hope in the future to also be a bit of a document of record and comment on current event and perhaps give a historical context. Welcome to my mad mad world of run on sentences and mental meandering


## So you've never heard of the Steering Committee




