Membership, Meetup and PayPal

Goal - To increase new members

Premise – It is my opinion that our high cost of membership (in comparison with similar groups) and the inability to sign up immediately for events like day hikes is making us an unattractive option for outdoor groups.

For similar groups, a potential member can see a weekend hike and sign up for both the club and the event through Meetup within minutes.

Currently any attempt to join us via Meetup gives a potential new member a rejection notice and sends them an email pointing them to our website or our monthly meeting. Our website does not have the ability to accept new members or to take payments. Our monthly meetings may not be convenient for potential new members and we have limited ability to take payments at meetings.

If a potential, new member does find a way to contact and pays us. There still has to be an interaction with Meetup to allow them to join events.

Similar groups are still attracting new members, even during COVID, where I do not believe that we are.

I believe that there is a lack of options for slower, shorter day hikes (5 to 7 miles) that we could take advantage of, if we move quickly to adopt changes.

I propose we make changes to membership and bylaws as needed

Change general membership to \$5 to be in line with other Meetup Groups

Use Meetup as the primary tool for managing membership

Connect Meetup to a PayPal account to be able to accept payment automatically

Set Meetup to approve new member requests automatically

No longer, offer any new Lifetime memberships

Grant David Warnecke access to Meetup to be able to review and enact changes as discussed by the steering committee

Additional Thoughts

<u>Gear Borrowing</u> – Anyone wanting to borrow gear would pay a once a year donation of \$35, after which gear borrowing would work exactly the same as it does today

Meetup security levels for Planners – Currently the only ID that has the ability to collect for events is the Solar account, to which no one I know has access. I would argue that at least the Activities Chair and Education Chair be allowed to do this. It would be ideal to allow them to have the Solar PayPal account attached to their posted events. I currently do not have access to the security levels to be able to review these settings

<u>Waivers</u> – I do not see a way to have a potential member sign an electronic waiver at the point of joining the club. There is some wordage in the Meetup agreement that offers protection. We do automatically send new members an email, in which we could ask for a waiver.
