- Beginning Backpacking Workshop is ongoing with two upcoming practicals.
- In conjunction with the BP workshop, there is a backcountry cooking workshop on April 27th. So far there are 9 participants but it will be promoted at this weekend's BP practical at Brighton Rec.
- Eric Braun, along with Jeff McWilliams are teaching a bike cleaning and tuning basics workshop on May 20 th, with a rain date of May 21st. The workshop will be hosted at Eric's home and may include a post-instructional bike ride. The workshop was posted on Meetup last week.
 - I have reached out to Jeff McWilliams about the Basic Land Navigation class. He and Tim Davis taught this in Spring 2022.
