## **Bylaws Karen Haroutunian**

- Draft of changes to the bylaws was sent out by Karen and again by Laura with the agenda.
   Discussion about the draft of the wording of the changes in combining the positions of historian/bylaws and public relations/communications steering committee positions. Social media posts should be part of the public relations/communications. Karen is editing the wording to reflect this in the changes to the bylaws.
- Carol moved to vote on changes and Mary D-W seconded. All in favor of the changes to the bylaws.

#### **Education Carol McCririe**

- Beginning Backpacking: This workshop is wrapping up with the final practical at Pinckney Recreation Area coming up May 2nd to 4t. We ended up with 11 participants.
- Bicycle Cleaning and Tuning Basics workshop: This is a one-day workshop on May 3 rd from 8 am to noon. The cost is \$15 if paid cash or check, \$20 if paid on meetup. It conflicts with the backpacking workshop because the original date was Mother's Day weekend.
- Basic Land Nav: This workshop is scheduled for classroom sessions on 9/18, 9/25, and 10/2 and have been approved by the church. The final practical will be at Waterloo Recreation area on 10/10-12.
- Wilderness First Aid: We have scheduled the weekend of October 25-26 and I believe that I have 10 people signed up. I have kept Kalamazoo college up to date on our numbers and have sent an email asking how and when they want payment. Carol will be arranging with participants about lodging near the course.

## **Equipment Chair Jeff McWilliams**

- Preliminary equipment report from the Beginner Backpacking Workshop:
  - We've had a lot of people borrow gear this year.
  - o We loaned out:
    - 4 tents
    - 6 backpacks
    - 8 sleeping bags
    - 7 sleeping pads
    - 3 tarps
    - 3 stoves
    - 4 water filters
  - Plus workshop volunteers grabbed some additional CCF pads and an extra sleeping bag just in case.

- We loaned out a lot more colder bags this year due to the 7-day forecast for the weekend showing overnight lows in the mid-30's.
- We loaned out all our lightweight inflatable sleeping pads.
- We loaned out 3 1P tents. Most of the couples/pairs taking the class provided their own tents, with one couple borrowing a 3P tent because they are both tall people.
- Frustratingly, some of our sleeping bags are missing their compression stuff sacks, so we had to steal stuff sacks from other bags. I will have to re-inventory stuff sacks and replace them where necessary.
