
Education Carol McCririe

Unfinished Business

- Tim to get quotes for 3 locations to use for general membership meetings. Tim reported in VP section.
- Jeff to get quotes for 3 locations for gear rental fees. Jeff provided gear rental fees.
- Discussions on lack of activities and how to encourage members to lead trips and offer workshops. Ongoing to work on getting more people to participate in hosting events. Tim talked about looking into a winter wilderness workshop.

New Business

- Budget for 2025, see Treasure's report.
- Is there a way that I can send email from this email address solarmembership@solaroutdoors.org
 - instead of my personal email? Dana asked Stacie but she is not at the meeting.
- Dana had another question about the website for the drop down carrot for workshops/activites: a
 panel comes up, with fee windows. Do we know what these are for and we should delete it from the
 website? This pay scale is not what we are doing. Is this a Stacie question or for Bob since he did
 things on the website before Stacie was webmaster.
- Raising gear rental fees to cover cost of storage Jeff to report findings on other organizations fees for gear rental. Jeff shared his screen with the spreadsheet. To be discussed at Feb. Steering committee meeting. **See next section.**
- Jeff asked should we raise the equipment fee? Should we have a late return fee? Discussion about this. Only twenty equipment fees collected to date this year which is not enough to cover the costs for the rental unit. Even split who borrow gear for the beginning backpacking workshop and other's who check out items regularly. Should we have a fee for each time they borrow equipment vs an annual fee? People who borrow for their own trips tend to have more late returns than with the workshops. Discussion about how a late fee would work and what the fee would be. To be discussed at Feb. Steering committee meeting. Discussion about raising the gear rental fee, fee of \$35 was from the old membership fee of \$40 so it was broken down to the original change of membership fee of \$5, gear rental fee of \$35. The current annual membership fee is \$15, so it has tripled. Gear rental fee has not changed to date. Late fee discussion having it and how we would process a late fee.
- Gear rental fee increase to \$50, a motion and secondd, vote passed by majority.
- Late fee policy to be discussed in the future.
- Should we just keep equipment for the workshops only? Our history is a unique club and some of the equipment we store is club equipment: for parties, tent, AV equipment and walkie talkies. To be discussed at Feb. Steering committee meeting. **See above comments**
- Discussion about raising the fee and what should it be? This needs to have more thought put into it. To be discussed at Feb. Steering committee meeting. **See above comments**
- Jeff was asked what his thoughts were about this. The idea of \$40-50 per event for a month rental. Mixed about a discount for workshop participants. To be discussed at Feb. Steering committee meeting. See above comments
- Motion to continue this discussion for the next meeting on Jan. 21, 2025 and voted to table the discussion. To be discussed at Feb. Steering committee meeting. See above comments
- Lifetime membership discussion in an email chain. Some discussion about asking lifetime members to donate to club in lieu of changing the lifetime membership. We took away any new lifetime memberships. We could still maintain the previous lifetime member. Previously, an email about donating to the club. Many times it is lifetime members. No change in policy on this matter.
