 final.

Equipment Chair Jeff McWilliams

- ST-06 is a JetBoil stove that was missing the bottom cup/cover for the heatsink fins. I've replaced the cup over concern that the fins could get damaged. Gear borrowers tend to be hard on gear.
- I'm noting that TNT25 is the Big Agnes tent that had a broken pole which has been repaired with a pole repair sleeve and epoxy. The damage to TNT25 happened last year during the Beginner Backpacking workshop up at Pictured Rocks. I just want to have the current state of the tent noted in gear list. This will be added to the description in the equipment list. It's my understanding that since it is an older tent, Big Agnes could not offer a replacement pole set.
- TNT31 and TNT32 have had the shock cord inside the pole sets replaced, as the original shock cord had stretched to the point where the poles would no longer snap together properly.
- I will be out of town for the July meeting, which also means I won't be present with the skills and equipment necessary to livestream the presentation. Someone else will need to get the projector, screen, and PA system from the gear storage unit before the meeting. Since Krisanne is out of town during the same dates as I am, she will also not be available to get these items. We need to discuss who's available that can get the items either with a key, or be given these items before I leave town. I leave very early on Friday July 21.
