# **Equipment Chair Phil Crookshank**

- The first 2 equipment borrowers since the last snowfall - or something like that picked up Gear 3 weeks ago, for a 3 person backpack trip around Grand Island. 2 New members, and the son of David Ferguson went, fearing the prediction of rain for the weekend, but they only got a small shower, backpacked around the whole perimeter, camped in 2 different places, got the shuttle back to Munising, ate heartily at the local Pasty shop, and headed home. David Jr. took the 1 person B.A. tent, said it worked well, for an almost 6 foot tall guy. They were hoping for the 3.5 inch thick sleeping pads, which were still out to the workshop, so took 2 ridgerest pads, and a 1-1/2 inch Thermarest pad for on top, and were comfortable. All is well that ends well.
- Jeff McWilliams had purchased a new China design 3fulgear Lanshan 2 person tent, brought it to the Highland workshop campout, Glen Schultz set it up, slept in it 2 nights, outside of unusual string tieouts that must NEVER be untied, he said it worked pretty well, uses 2 trekking poles, no other supports. So I set it up in my yard on a windy day, stretched it out, laid down for a 5 minute snooze, checked everything, noticed that the wind was making lots of flapping noise, but that is common with this type of design. So I put it all away, named it TNT-35, 2 person, bathtub floor, 2.7 # even with a sturdy plastic ground sheet that Jeff made up for it. Thanks Jeff, for the search, and the donation of this new design tent that will fill a spot for 2 people to sleep in.
- FINALLY, the Schoolcraft road that has made entry and exit to our gear room impossible some days is almost halfway done, so this last time in we were able to get out with no staff there to help, I got stuck in there twice during the road out, lucky that someone else came in to trigger the gate at 10:30pm.
- I sent the new equipment list that has the tent mentioned to Stacie, and she converted it to PDF and put it on the website already, for new members to peruse, and get excited about. Another new member Jillian, wants one of the 2 person B.A. tents for a last of October backpack, so we will make sure to have one at the 27<sup>th</sup> Oct. meeting for use.

Krisanne reports one of the Big Agnes tents for the Beginner Backpacking class has a broken pole. The equipment will be returned at the meeting and the charge will be figured out with the group how borrowed the tent.
